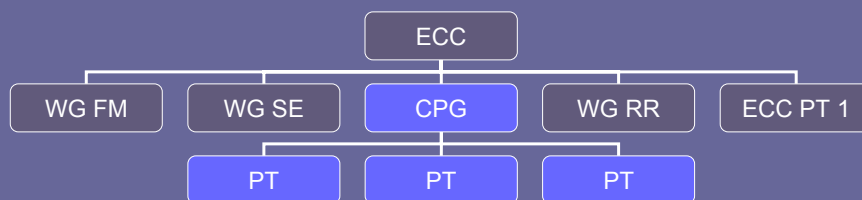

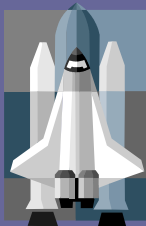

## Aeronautical issues



- aeronautical telecommand and high bit-rate aeronautical telemetry in frequency bands above 3 GHz (1.5)
- aeronautical mobile ( R ) service in the bands between 108 MHz and 6 GHz and satellite frequency allocations (1.6)

## Satellite issues



- mobile-satellite service in the band 1 668-1 668.4 MHz and 1 668.4-1 675 MHz (1.7)
- procedures and technical criteria of Appendix **30B** (1.10)
- changes to “Coordination and notification procedures for satellite networks” (1.12)
- fixed satellite service and other services around 1.4 GHz (1.17)
- systems 17.7-19.7 GHz using highly inclined orbits (1.18)

## IMT-2000 related issues



- frequency-related matters for the future development of IMT-2000 and systems beyond IMT-2000 (1.4)
- provisions applicable to the use of the band 2 500-2 690 MHz by space services in order to facilitate sharing with current and future terrestrial services without placing undue constraint on the services to which the band is allocated (1.9)

### Shortwave issues

- review the allocations to all services in the HF bands between 4 MHz and 10 MHz, excluding those allocations to services in the frequency range 7 000-7 200 kHz and certain other frequency bands (1.13);

### Broadcasting

- sharing criteria and regulatory provisions for protection of terrestrial services, in particular terrestrial television broadcasting services, in the band 620-790 MHz from BSS networks and systems (1.11)

## Maritime issues



- operational procedures and requirements of the Global Maritime Distress and Safety System (GMDSS) and other related provisions of the Radio Regulations, taking into account the continued transition to the GMDSS, the experience since its introduction and the needs of all classes of ships (1.14);
- regulatory and operational provisions for Maritime Mobile Service Identities (MMSIs) for equipment other than shipborne mobile equipment (1.16)

## Future conferences

- to consider and approve the Report of the Director of the Radiocommunication Bureau (7.1)
  - on any difficulties or inconsistencies encountered in the application of the Radio Regulations
  - options to improve the international spectrum regulatory framework (part of 7.1)
- to recommend to the Council items for inclusion in the agenda for the next WRC, and to give its views on the preliminary agenda for the subsequent conference and on possible agenda items for future conferences (7.2)
